About TT Runs

The TT Runs project started with a fairly simple idea—to create a wide modern geometric grotesque, which will reflect the sporty style and look good on sportswear. Before proceeding to sketching, we examined the theme of Olympic venues and their identities, and also traced the evolution of “sports” fonts through different eras and continents.

In the end, we came up with the idea of making a typeface that is targeted for application to elastic sports outfits or casual sportswear. This decision has greatly influenced the appearance of the wide and slightly stretched proportions in our typeface, the appearance of the reversed contrast of the shape of some characters relative to the vertical line and their deformation, and the overall plasticity of the letters.

TT Runs is very versatile: on the one hand it is a regular grotesque that can be used even in a large text array, and on the other hand it is a bright display typeface with irregular proportions of characters that looks great even in large headings.

A striking feature of the typeface is the difference between the top and bottom, the so-called inverse contrast of the shape relative to the vertical line, which is especially noticeable in uppercase characters (for example, in the letters K, C, S, R). In lowercase characters, everything is calmer and more traditional, the reverse contrast of the forms relative to the vertical line is greatly softened and almost invisible. The main visual features of the typeface also include a large vertical height of lowercase characters.

Moreover, the bolder the weight of the style, the taller the height of the lowercase character becomes. In addition, when the demibold weight is reached, the design of some characters changes, for example, a vertical stroke in bold for characters with a dot at the top bends into an arc.

TT Runs consists of 18 styles (9 upright and 9 oblique), each of which includes 739 glyphs. In addition to the broad language coverage in the typeface, you can find a bunch of useful OpenType features. Stylistic alternates, standard and discretionary ligatures, old-style figures, numbers in circles, arrows and much more. Whilst SportAccord recognises a small number of mind sports, it is not open to admitting any further mind sports.

TT Runs Thin Italic 16 pt

Sports have been increasingly organised and regulated from the time of the ancient Olympics up to the present century.

TT Runs ExtraLight Italic 16 pt

The measurement of the result may be objective or subjective, and corrected with "handicaps" or penalties.

TT Runs Light Italic 16 pt

Examples

The widespread existence of gambling on the results of sports fixtures creates a motivation for match fixing.

TT Runs Regular 16 pt

Gender balance has been accelerating from a 32% increase in 1973–74 to a 63% increase in 1994–95. Hessel [2000].

TT Runs Medium 16 pt

The popularity of spectator sport as a recreation for non-participants has led to sport becoming a major business.

TT Runs DemiBold 16 pt

Despite gains during the last three decades, a gap persists in the enrollment figures between male & female players.

TT Runs Italic 16 pt

In the 2006 World Cup football final attracted an estimated worldwide audience of well over 700 million people.

TT Runs Medium Italic 16 pt

With it being a necessary part of some sports [such as motorsport], it is used in others to improve performance.

TT Runs DemiBold Italic 16 pt

Examples

Sports science is a widespread academic discipline, and can be applied to areas incl. athlete performance.

TT Runs Bold 16 pt

Until recently the GAA continued to ban the playing of football and rugby union at Gaelic venues.

TT Runs Bold Italic 16 pt

Nationalism is often evident in the pursuit of sport, or in its reporting: people compete in national teams.

TT Runs ExtraBold 16 pt

The shows, says Tertullian, excite passions foreign to the calm temperament cultivated by the Christian.

TT Runs ExtraBold Italic 16 pt

A study of US elections has shown that the result of sports events can affect the results.

TT Runs Black 16 pt

Brazil have won five times, and they are the only team to have played in every tournament.

The first two World Cup matches took place simultaneously on 13 July 1930, and were won by France and the US, who defeated Mexico 4–1 and Belgium 3–0 respectively. The first goal in World Cup history was scored by Lucien Laurent of France.

In the final, Uruguay defeated Argentina 4–2 in front of 93,000 people in Montevideo, and became the first nation to win the World Cup.^[14] After the creation of the World Cup, FIFA and the IOC disagreed over the status of amateur players, and so football was dropped from the 1932 Summer Olympics. Olympic football returned at the 1936 Summer Olympics.
